All records relied upon or reviewed in making the following statement in the City of Chicago's 2014 Annual Financial Analysis (p. 78): "The City's TIFs had an aggregate balance of \$1.72 billion at the close of 2013, decreasing to \$1.69 billion in active TIFs at the start of 2014. However, \$1.67 billion of this balance is reserved for payments due in connection with committed projects, including a portion that is reserved to fund project costs in TIF districts where revenues are declining, in the event that annual revenues are insufficient to pay future obligations."
2. All records documenting any obligations reflected in the \$1.67 billion figure in the 2014 AFA.
3. All records documenting any funds currently reserved for payments due in connection with committed projects, including a portion that is reserved to fund project costs in TIF districts where revenues are declining, in the event that annual revenues are insufficient to pay future obligations.
